Fort Worth Police Northwest Division Crime Prevention Program is partnering with Northside Recreation Center to provide area Seniors (65+) and vulnerable adults with intellectual or development disabilities with Fingerprint/ID cards. Preventing Package Theft

'Tis the season for package theft. The Fort Worth Police Department has provided some tips to prevent package theft during the holiday season.

- Try to schedule delivery when someone is going to be home
- Require a signature on package delivery when possible
- Have packages delivered to a neighbor who is home
- Have a trusted friend pick up your package and hold it for you
- Have packages delivered to your workplace
- If you order from Amazon, have the package delivered to one of their locker locations
- If you witness any suspicious activity in your neighborhood, call the police

- If you are a victim of package theft, call and report the theft immediately
