March Gardening Tips

The average last frost date for north Texas is March 20. Fossil Creek Tree Farm and Dallas County Master Gardener's Association recommend March as a good time for the following.

Plant:

ornamental trees and shrubs
beans, corn, cucumber, tomato,
pumpkin, and squash
cool season flowers such as alyssum,
daisies, dianthus, and geraniums
(mid to late March)

Prune:

Prune overgrown ground cover
before new growth begins.
Cut back ornamental grasses before
new growth appears.
Remove winter damage from
shrubs and other ornamentals.

Plant Care:

Fertilize established shade trees,
ornamental trees, and
shrubs.
Continue to protect tender plants
from late freezes.
